County Judge announced a shelter in place order effective immediately.

GEORGETOWN, TX, March 24, 2020 —

Williamson County Judge, Bill Gravell, has declared a “Shelter in Place” order for all of Williamson County effective immediately. Please [click here for a copy of the order](#).

All non-essential businesses have been ordered to close and have employees work from home. Individuals should refrain from leaving their places of residence except to do essential tasks, such as grocery shopping, visiting pharmacies and medical trips. All public gatherings are prohibited under the order.

“In response to the Judge’s order, the Chamber will move to a virtual operations and will be available to assist you with any questions or concerns” said Georgetown Chamber of Commerce & CEO, Jim Johnson. “We will continue to be available via phone and email during normal Chamber business hours.”
